Rules for camping to answer frequently asked questions:

- Campsite requests are taken into consideration upon booking. Final campsite placement is at the discretion of the Ranger. Placement is based on availability and the needs of Camp.
- All units/campers are to provide their own camping tents, equipment, gear, and meals.
- ~ NO PETS ALLOWED IN CAMP! No exceptions!
- The speed limit in camp is 15mph in the lower camp and 25mph in the Scout World area.
- Security Gate Closes at 9:00 pm to enter facility. You can exit at any time.
- Check-in begins at 4pm on Fridays and the last check-in should happen no later than 8pm.
- Check-out is no later than 11:30a on Sunday morning. That means all kids must be picked up and campsite must be clean by that time.
- There will be a clean-up fee for any site that does not adhere to "Leave No Trace".
- Ranger lives on property if an emergency arises.
- Cell Phone, Internet, or WiFi service reception is very limited or not available in camp depending on your service provider.
- If you wish to bring your RV on property you **MUST** have prior written approval from the Ranger or they will not be allowed to enter camp; additional fees may apply.
- No RV electrical/water/sewer hookups available.
- There is no vehicle parking in any campsite. All troop trailers must be dropped to be used in the campsite.
- Every campsite comes with a parking area that adequately reflects the capacity of the site. Vehicles must back-in per National policy.
- There is one or more potable water spigot in each campsite to service the entire site.
- Firestone Scout Reservation is a No Smoking/ Vape Facility.
- NO WOOD OR GROUND FIRES ALLOWED! Charcoal and Propane are allowed.
- Trash Bags Please bring plenty of trash bags to bag and dispose of your trash. Additionally, take all trash with you when leaving camp. We are a pack in pack out facility and abide by "leave no trace".
- Firestone runs a volunteer-based program, please be patient if we have difficulty in staffing or have a delayed response to inquiries.
